A Message from our President Dave Clancy

Dear Members and Friends,

As we move into a more active season at Sycamore Creek a number of questions have been raised with regards to capital expenditures and improvements to the club and how they can be funded. Our financial situation is much more stable with the debt refinancing completed and solid membership gains through the spring, but our revenue levels still do not allow for significant capital purchases to be made from within our club's budget.

In order to provide funds for club improvements where membership interest was high and there was a willingness to contribute, the Friends of Sycamore (FOS) was created as a fundraising group within SCCC. The FOS committee is led by Dave Callahan and is a **separate entity** and **independent from the SCCC Board and the general fund of SCCC**. Funds donated to FOS are maintained outside of the club's operating budget with expenditures controlled by the FOS committee once board approval has been received. A few projects that FOS has overseen are the clubhouse interior renovation in 2016, repair of the pond fountain on the 9th hole, and the Tiki Bar rebuild to be unveiled Memorial Day weekend. Club committees also engage with the FOS and currently the House Committee is looking to complete funding for an inter décor project in the dining areas.

During the short history of the FOS over 40 members have made contributions that have greatly benefited the club. Funds can be donated to FOS with multiple purposes in mind. General donations can be made with the intent being to allow the FOS committee to determine how they are to be allocated. Also, a donation can be made with a targeted purpose in mind, such as to purchase new furnishings for the pool or a piece of equipment for the golf course. Finally, a member or group of members can approach the FOS committee with an improvement project in mind, seek approval and then request assistance in raising the funds necessary to proceed with the project. All donations are welcomed and much appreciated.

In challenging financial times the FOS have proven to be a very beneficial group to the club in completing projects both large and small and have sought to maximize the impact of each donated dollar.

Like many of you I am looking forward to sunnier and warmer days at Sycamore Creek and enjoying all that our wonderful club has to offer.

House Committee Updates

Fellow SCCC Members,

As Chair of the House Committee, I wanted to let you know that we are making some improvements to the interior décor of the Clubhouse. When the major Club renovations were completed last year, some new artwork was added, but we have many areas that need more art, accessories and color.

We have initiated these efforts, but we are funding this outside of the Club budget and we need your help. Six generous donations have been received to date, totaling approximately \$1700. (Dave and Mikki Clancy, Jay and Cindy Sitzman, Tom and Dianne Meyer, Jason and Lisa Bigby, Chuck and Faye Geidner, and Bob and Sharon Lowry) We need additional funding so we can continue these efforts. Our goal is to have most items completed by the Men's Member-Guest event in late June.

A lesson learned from the earlier updates was that we need professional help. We are working with an interior designer and we have identified a number of areas that can quickly benefit from a combination of new, repurposed and refinished items to enhance the Clubhouse interior. The mantels were the primary concern identified by the committee, but there are many other areas that will benefit.

With a mix of professional and volunteer efforts, and new and older items, we have made some progress on the updates...

- ✓ The Lounge side of the mantel has been totally redecorated. Take a Look!
- ✓ Several furniture pieces have been refinished – two tables and a hutch
- ✓ The hutch was relocated to the entry hallway and accessorized
- ✓ Five existing pictures were cleaned, repaired and rehung, plus two new ones with new frames
- ✓ A vintage course layout that appears to be from the 1960's was located, cleaned, repaired and rehung
- ✓ Three new posters showcasing our members and activities are now framed and located in the entryway
- ✓ Several floral arrangements are being updated with a fresh look and more color

- The Dining Room mantel will be redone to complement the Lounge side design
- An additional table is needed for the hostess area
- Floor vases are planned for either side of the entryway table and one near the hostess stand
- Accessories are needed to complement certain areas

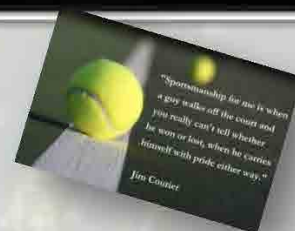
