E.A. Tischler was born in Sunnyvale, CA and attended UCSD where he finished his senior year as the Number #1 Player, Team Captain and was a member of the school's Athletic Council. While at UCSD he pursued degrees in Philosophy, Economics and Psychology. In 1989 he turned professional and has been playing and coaching ever since. As a player he honed his skills to a +4.5 handicap, compiled 10 hole-in-ones, 2 double eagles, set over 20 course records, and won 30+ professional tournaments. He has self-published 28 golf instructional books, invented and patented a variety of golf training aids, and has helped dozens of golfers achieve their goals of playing professional golf. Before joining The Woodlands CC as the Director of Instruction E.A. was the Director of Instruction for Olympia Fields CC outside of Chicago for 11 years, 3 years at Inverness Club in Toledo Ohio as the Director of Instruction, and spent 25 years coaching Hawaii, California and abroad. E.A. has been a Golf Magazine Top 100 Instructor since 2015, 2017-18 Golf Digest Top 50 Instructor, is on Golf Digest's Best Teachers in State lists annually, and is a PGA Tour Coach having coached players to 50+ professional wins. Throughout his career he has worked with players like Dean Wilson, Perter Jacobsen, Stan Utley, Tom Pernice Jr, Brandt Jobe and many more. He also coached Scott McCarron to the 2019 Charles Schwab Cup season long championship.

As a professional coach he has dedicated his career and life to the game of golf in the quest for providing all golfers the tools they need to Own their swings and their games. Throughout that process he founded the New Horizons Golf Approach, BioSwing Coaching and developed the Power-of-3 Golf Biomechanics System which he introduced in his Secrets of Owning Your Swing book series. His short game and scoring approach is called the Fore54 Scoring System through which each player learns their own best way to play the game. He has also been an Inner Game Coach throughout his whole career having been mentored by Fred Shoemaker (Founder of Extraordinary Golf). Among the Top 100 Instructor community E.A. is known by many as "The Pro's Pro" because of how many coaches he has mentored and how many of them seek his knowledge regarding best practices and the science of the game. He is known to be one of the most energetic and enthusiastic coaches in the game. He believes improving is the standard and to do so we must be committed to continually learning. Lastly, he is always willing to share his knowledge with coaches and students.
